

This checklist helps to ensure that you have included all of the necessary documentation that is needed by the Australian High Commission to process your visa application.

How to use this checklist

1. Before you lodge your visa application form, use this checklist to ensure that you have included all necessary documentation to support your claims. You do not need to upload this checklist; however you may wish to do so as an attachment to your Immiaccount.

Other important information

Please be aware that the decision on your visa application may be decided on the information and documentation that you include at the time of lodgement.

Delivery and courier charges

If you are requested to provide additional information, you should do so only through your Immiaccount.

About the documentation that you include:

- You must include scan of all documents; you may be asked to provide originals at a later stage depending on the case.
- Documentation must be either in English or a certified translation must be included with the certified original

<p>Any child under the age of 18 years who is traveling without either one or both of the parents, a statutory declaration from the non-traveling parent/s must be provided or Form 1229 Consent form to grant an Australian visa to a child under the age of 18 years from the non-traveling parent/s or guardian must be provided.
