

**NON AUSTRALIANS WHO CAN COMPLETE
THE GUARANTOR SECTION
(OCCUPATION GROUPS)**

To qualify as a guarantor, you must:

- be over 18 years of age and easily contactable by telephone during normal business hours;
 - have known the applicant for 12 months or more (for babies younger than 12 months, since birth);
 - **NOT** be related to the applicant or applicant's parents by birth, marriage or defacto relationship (this includes cousins, uncles, aunties, grand parents etc.)
 - **NOT** to be living at the same address, as the applicant

- Be currently employed in one of the following occupational groups
 1. Bank Manager except managers of bank travel centres
 2. Barristers, Solicitors, Patent Attorneys and Clerk of Courts
 3. Chartered Accountants
 4. Chartered Professional Engineers
 5. Registered Medical Practitioners / Dentists / Pharmacists / Physiotherapists / Nurses or Midwives
 6. Elected representatives of federal, Union Council, Metropolitan Corporation, State and Territory Parliaments, MNA, MPA
 7. Judges
 8. Military officers at or above the rank of Major (Army) / Lieutenant Commander (Navy) / Squadron Leader (Airforce) with at least five years continuous service
 9. Police Officers with at least five years continuous service
 10. Public Servants of local government (grade 17 or above) who have been employed continuously for five years by their current employer
 11. Teachers who have been teaching for more than five years at school or tertiary institution

The guarantor must endorse the back of the photograph by writing **"THIS IS A TRUE PHOTOGRAPH OF (applicant's name in full)"** and signing
